Coffee & Fellowship and a Video!

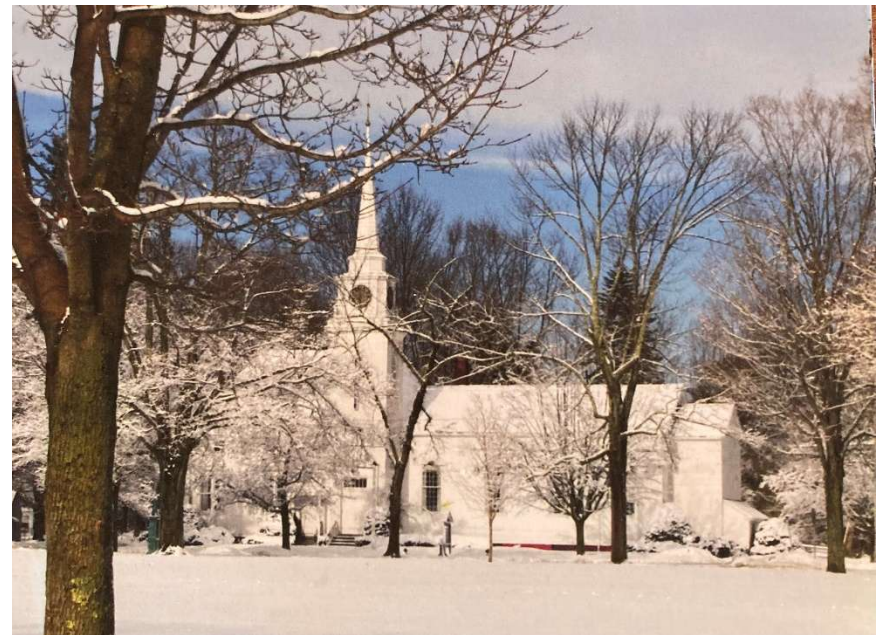
